Former member of the U.S. House of Representatives
from Virginia's 10th district

Barbara Jean Comstock was elected to Congress in 2014, and served two terms representing Virginia's Tenth Congressional District, making her the first woman elected to that seat. She was named as one of the "Top Ten Most Effective Lawmakers" in the 115th Congress by the Center for Effective Lawmaking, a joint effort of the University of Virginia and Vanderbilt University.

(1993 - 2019)

Democrat

Former member of the U.S. House of Representatives
from Texas's 29th district

Raymond Eugene (Gene) Green was first elected to Congress in 1992 after twenty years in the Texas House of Representatives and the Texas Senate. He served 22 years on the U. S. House Energy and Commerce Committee. He served as the Ranking Member for the Subcommittee on Health. He also served on the Energy and Environment Subcommittee and the Digital Commerce and Consumer Protection Subcommittee.
